# Glendale Community Townhomes

The Minneapolis Public Housing Authority (MPHA) is making plans on tearing down and rebuilding the Glendale Townhomes to update the homes available, increase density and change the housing stock to a mixed income model. The residents of the Glendale Townhomes have been meeting with each other and with MPHA to discuss the plans and express opinions on the changes. The City of Minneapolis has sent out notification of the opportunity to review and comment on the proposed Glendale Housing Development Project Plan. The Plan is to be the subject of a public hearing at the July 14 meeting of the CD&RS Committee. If approved by the City Council, the Plan establishes a new Housing Development Project, enabling the City and the Minneapolis Public Housing Authority to carry out redevelopment activity at the Glendale Townhomes site.

# Sign Up for Organics Recycling

Minneapolis Solid Waste and Recycling customers who live in the <u>first-phase rollout</u> <u>areas</u> can still sign up by July 10 to get green carts during the August rollout. (For future deliveries, people can sign up any time.)

Here are five good reasons for people to sign up:

- 1. To reduce waste. More than a third of our trash is organic material that can be composted. Most families can divert up to 10 pounds of materials to organics recycling each week.
- 2. To help create more compost. Things like meat, bones, dairy products and compostable plastics can't go in a backyard composting bin, but they can be collected through organics recycling and turned into compost.
- 3. To save money. Once you start producing less trash, you may be able to switch to a smaller garbage cart, which will cut \$3 off your monthly bill.
- 4. To be a part of the sustainability trend. More than 29,500 households have already signed up to participate.
- 5. To help improve soil quality. Using compost returns nutrients to the soil, reduces erosion, and reduces the needs for watering and for chemical fertilizers.
