MN/DOT ACTION ON FREEWAY NOISE - UPDATE

Mn/DOT plans three actions this summer to address the increased noise in the Luxton Park area due to the Interstate 94 reconstruction between Franklin Ave. and Riverside Ave. that was completed last year.

- 1. Pavement grinding is scheduled to begin on July 20 and will continue for about eighteen days from approximately 10PM until 5AM. The contractor has the option of working weekends as well as weekdays.
- 2. Preliminary noise measurements have been completed at several sites to determine the noise levels prior to grinding. Measurements will be taken again after the completion of the pavement grinding, and again after the installation of the noise wall in Luxton Park.
- Construction of a noise wall in Luxton Park will commence after the completion of the pavement grinding and the second set of noise measurements.

St Francis Cabrini Church Considering New Parking

St. Frances Cabrini Community is in the process of planning a parking lot for their church at the corner of Franklin Avenue and East River Terrace. It will be built along the railroad tracks on the far East end of their property. Plans for landscaping are in progress. Those plans will provide for maintaining most of the trees on the lot including all of the mature Oaks. The parking lot is intended:

- to provide additional parking for parishioners for main services;
- to provide parking that is more accessible for the handicapped;
- to relieve the use of Franklin Avenue and East River Terrace streets;
- o to reduce safety concerns with on-street parking; and
- o to provide church-based parking for weekday services and activities.

The plans include leasing the lot during weekdays only to University Good Samaritan Care Center. Parking at those times will be available to Care Center employees.

Some kind of zoning change or special council permit will apparently be necessary for the project to proceed.

Several meetings have been held with the immediate neighbors of the church. Concerns have been expressed over:

- the reality of the need for the parking lot;
- unfortunate changes in storm drainage;
- the loss of land used for gardening by neighbors;
- o the loss of any trees; and
- the effect on neighborhood safety.

The PPERRIA Zoning and Planning Committee will review final plans. Please contact Allison Savin at 339-3300 for information.
