Luxton Park Council would like to release the funds reallocated previously \$5,000 to PARC A.1.d. to these strategies. MOTION TO RELEASE FUNDS FOR PRATT COMMUNITY SCHOOL TO K-5 (EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE)

Motion: To release \$495,628 from Education A.1.a. Neighborhood **Education Center to complete reno**vation and growth of Pratt Community School to K-5.

Pratt Community School will grow over the next two years to become a

K-5 school for our community. In order for this to happen, the Minneapolis School District will renovate the space formerly occupied by the Loft. The school will also cover costs in staffing and materials associated with growing the school. In addition, the

district will create a fire stair to the third floor, opening a way to access additional community space in the building.
