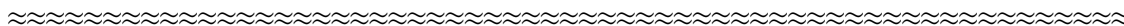

**St. Frances Cabrini Indigenous Outreach Team presents:
What is Tribal Sovereignty and Why is it important?**

Dr. Jacob Juss will examine the roots of tribal sovereignty from the Doctrine of Discovery to treaties to key developments in federal Indian law which impact Tribal Nations today.

In June 2023 the Supreme Court issued their opinion in the case of *Haaland v. Brackeen* defending the constitutionality of the Indian Child Welfare Act (ICWA). On the surface this case appeared to be concerned with the protection of indigenous children, but more insidiously the case also turned on the issue of tribal sovereignty and had the potential to severely limit the sovereignty of tribal nations.
